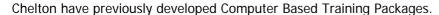

Operator and Maintenance Course

Operator and Maintenance courses are predominantly performed within a customers facility and preferably on the platform. We have training rooms and permanent vehicle mock ups to simulate the environment if this is a preferred method of training

• Operation and Maintenance of equipment at Operator and Organisational Level. Fault finding to Line Replaceable Unit (LRU) level.
